REGISTRATION:

Race Day Registration opens at 8:00am and closes when the previous race finishes. The **Registration** desk is located in the vicinity of [41 Northwest Drive](#), Plainville, CT. **There is a race day, late registration surcharge of \$10.00.** A USA Cycling License MUST be presented at Registration. One-day licenses will be available for \$12.00.

From Hartford: I-84 south to exit 39, Rte.4 west, turn left onto Rte.10 south, turn right onto Northwest Dr., turn left onto Farmington Valley Dr.

From Waterbury: I-84 north to exit 33, Rte.72 west, to first exit, turn right onto Rte.177, turn right onto Northwest Dr., turn right onto Farmington Valley Dr.

From Torrington: Rte.4 east, turn right onto Rte.177 south, turn left onto Northwest Dr., turn right onto Farmington Valley Dr.

Course Description: flat, no hills, 0.5 miles, wide smooth pavement, two wide ninety degree turns.

Women: [USCF rule 1H2](#) determines race category eligibility.

Minimum Field: If the number of entries, 30 minutes prior to any race, is less than the minimum field size, then the organizer may cancel the race and refund fees and surcharges. If the organizer conducts a race with less than 20 entries, then the race day cash prizes are cancelled.

Reporting: The first ten finishing places will be reported to USA Cycling.

Scoring: Points are awarded as follows: 1st 7 pts., 2nd 5 pts., 3rd 4 pts., 4th 3 pts., 5th 2 pts., 6th 1 pts. There are two primes per race: 1st place prime 2 pts, 2nd place prime 1 pts. Overall series leaders are tracked according to points awarded each week. Overall Team Series scoring is based on the team's three highest scoring riders for the entire series. Riders may protest point totals within seven (7) days of posting and before the following event

Upgrade Points: If USAC minimum field sizes are met ([re: USA Cycling Rulebook](#)), then these points (excluding primes) are USAC upgrade points and may be included in your race resume USAC Category upgrade application.

Inclement Weather Cancellations: Check the Eastern Bloc Cycling Club website forum (<http://www.easternbloc.net>) for race status. Refresh the page to make sure you have the latest page available.

PRIZES:

Schedule A (Criteriums):

Individual–Race Day: **\$4.00 per race entry**, **PLUS Other Donated Contributions**, funds each race day prize pool, Race Day Prize Pool to be announced at the starting line. Cash prizes are awarded as a prize pool percentage:

1st 21% (\$20 min.), 2nd 15%, 3rd 11%, 4th 9%, 5th 6%, 6th 4%, Prime No. 1 - 1st 9%, 2nd 6%, Prime No. 2 - 1st 11%, 2nd 8%

Individual-Series one time, end of series award by race, **\$0.50 per race category entry** accumulated through the series, **PLUS Other Donated Contributions**, funds the end of series cash prize, 1st 57%, 2nd 29%, 3rd 14%

Team-Series one time, end of series award by race, **\$1.50 per race category entry** accumulated through the series, **PLUS Other Donated Contributions**, funds the end of series cash prize, 1st 57%, 2nd 29%, 3rd 14%

Prize payment plan: Prizes are paid per race and not per rider category. There is one prize payment in mixed category fields. Cash prizes are paid on the day of race, on-site, after the 15 minute protest period and at the registration desk after a mandatory podium photograph. Prizes not collected on the race day are forfeited.

Miss 'N Out Race Rules:

1st Lap is neutral and riders proceed around the course and through the Start Line in a group. If riders do not pass through in a neutral group, then the chief official will order another neutral lap. Every Lap thereafter, the last rider across the Finish Line is 'pulled' from the course. When three (3) riders remain, one (1) neutral lap is ridden. The last lap determines places 1, 2 and 3.
