- 1) One lap length is 0.5 miles of flat, wide, smooth pavement with two, wide ninety degree turns.
 - 2) Fee for 2nd Race is \$15.00. Race Day registration surcharge \$10.00.
 - 3) Finishing a Race within the peleton conducted earlier the same day is required.
 - 4) In the Miss 'N Out, the number of laps equals the number of riders.
 - 5) Registration By Invitation ONLY, contact race organizer, qualifications include but are not limited to:
 - a. Individual points earned during the previous race days
 - b. First 10, 10, 5, & 5 scoring riders respectively from the 4/5, 3/4, 4/5 > 39yo races
 - c. Team membership
 - 6) USA Cycling Rule Book, Paragraph 1J7 Maximum Field.

Registration: Pre-Registration closes at 11:59pm, Thursday before Race Day. Race Day Registration opens at 8:00am and closes when the previous race finishes. The Registration desk is located in the vicinity of [41 Northwest Drive](#), Plainville, CT. There is a Race Day, Late Registration Surcharge of \$10.00. The Team, not Club, listed on your USAC License is the Team credited with any Series Race Points won. USAC License required.

- 2) **Warm Down Lap:** After crossing the Finish Line, riders must turn right and complete one 'warm down lap.'
- 3) **Women:** [USA Cycling Rule Book para 1K2](#) determines race category eligibility.
- 4) **Minimum Field Size** is 20. If the number of entries, 30 minutes prior to any race, is less than the minimum field size, then the organizer may cancel the race and refund fees. If the organizer conducts a race with less than 20 entries, then the race day cash prizes are cancelled.
- 5) **Scoring:** Points are awarded as follows: 1st 7 pts., 2nd 5 pts., 3rd 4 pts., 4th 3 pts., 5th 2 pts., 6th 1 pts. There are two primes per race: **Prime 1**- 1st place 2 pts, 2nd place 1 pts. **Prime 2**- 1st place 3 pts, 2nd place 2 pts. Overall series leaders are tracked according to points awarded each week. Riders may protest point totals within seven (7) days of posting and before the following event. The Team, not Club, listed on your USAC License is the Team credited with any Race Points won.
- 6) **USAC Road Category Upgrade Points:** This is a USAC sanctioned event. **USAC category upgrade points are awarded in accordance with [USA Cycling Rule Book para 1D2](#).**

7) **Inclement Weather Cancellations:** IF the Race is cancelled by the Organizer, THEN riders receive 100% Race Fee reimbursement. [Follow PSSRacing on Twitter.com](#)

Prizes:

1) **Schedule A** (Criteriums):

- a) **Individual–Race Day** : **\$4.00 per race entry** funds each race day prize pool, Race Day Prize Pool to be announced at the starting line. Cash Prizes are awarded as a prize pool percentage;
 - i) Prime No. 1 – 1st 9%, 2nd 6%
 - ii) Prime No. 2 – 1st 11%, 2nd 8%
 - iii) Final Points Total (Placing/Prize), 1st 21%, 2nd 15%, 3rd 11%, 4th 9%, 5th 6%, 6th 4%
- b) **Individual-Series** **\$0.50 per race category entry** accumulated through the series funds the end of series prize pool
 - i) Final Points Total (Placing/Prize), 1st 57%, 2nd 29%, 3rd 14%,
- c) **Team-Series** **\$1.50 per race category entry** accumulated through the series funds the end of series prize pool
 - i) Final Points Total (Placing/Prize), 1st 57%, 2nd 29%, 3rd 14%,

Prize payment plan: Prizes are paid per race and not per rider category. There is one prize payment in mixed category fields. Cash prizes are paid on the day of race, on-site, and at the registration desk. Prizes not collected on the race day are forfeited. The cash prize for the team scoring the most points for the entire series is based on the team’s three highest scoring riders each day of the entire series (note: *important change from previous years*).

Miss ‘N Out Race Rules: 1st Lap is neutral and riders proceed around the course and through the Start Line in a group. If riders do not pass through in a neutral group, then the chief official will order another neutral lap. Every Lap thereafter, the last rider across the Finish Line ‘finishes’ and is ‘pulled’ from the course. When three (3) riders remain, one (1) neutral lap is ridden. The last lap determines places 1, 2 and 3.
